Reminder that we lead the Rosary on October 19<sup>th</sup>- Father Andrew suggested just one person lead and the others take the part of parishioners to keep better in sync.

SANSI- explained this ministry to Fr. Andrew. John advised there are 24 enrolled and we no longer pack the bags—they come packed from HACAP. John is doing the pickup/delivery. 3 St. Isidore parishioners are on the SANSI board—John Roberts is President/Yvette is Secretary and Al Meyer is Treasurer. Family Promise- explained this ministry to Fr. Andrew and Connie advised St. Wenceslaus will host Nov 10-17 and we are signed up for Sunday evening meal as well as “hosting” from 6-8 pm. Connie & Jim Sjostrom and Yvette and John Moravec will host this time. Connie will have a sign up out for 2 weeks prior and then cook and deliver Sunday Nov 10<sup>th</sup>.

Feed the Hungry- Catholic Worker House- by doing these “back to back” more people are able to get involved in the donation process. Sign ups will be out at the same time as Family Promise and Connie will cook/deliver if no one else can.

Tanager Place Angel Tags—Julie had emailed regard to other options also available including “sponsor a family” Adopt a Cottage, Adopt a Tanager Program, Hat & Mitten trees and family game drives. Committee consensus would be we continue with the Angel Tag tree and that our commission members would “Sponsor a Family”. Julie will notify Tanager and we will get the info as the date approaches.

Visit the Sick—we have a new supply of our prayer crosses blessed by Father Andrew. They are in a basket in the Gathering Space with a notation for the process if someone is interested.

Health Care Ethics—Betty is willing to lead a program again this year and we will put a notice in the bulletin to determine the interest.

All Saints Haiti trip—this has been cancelled due to unrest in Haiti. The shipping crate will still be packed and as we get information on the items needed and the dates, we will set up a box.

October is Respect Life Month. The Rose Drive appeal with the Knights of Columbus will be October 19<sup>th</sup>. The All Saints Social Justice committee is hosting a Faithful Citizenship presentation on October 22 from 6:30- 8:00 p.m. Additional posters will come from the Archdiocese on Respect Life topics and will be on the website as well.

St Isidore will host the Ecumenical Service in Springville on Sunday evening November 24<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. Candy will remind Community Life of this at the upcoming Council meeting. Our Youth Choir will participate.
